Asylum Seekers Hold Second Day of Protest on Nauru

Asylum seekers on Nauru held a protest at the gates of the family compound, RPC 3, for the second day in a row, beginning at 5.00pm Nauru time.

Many of the asylum seekers are still waiting for answers to their refugee claims for more than two-and half years.

The Nauru protest began on Palm Sunday coinciding with the Palm Sunday "Welcome Refugee" rallies calling for the closure of Manus Island and Nauru. The start of the protests also coincided with the start of the Iranian New Year - symbolically marking the beginning of yet another year in offshore detention.
